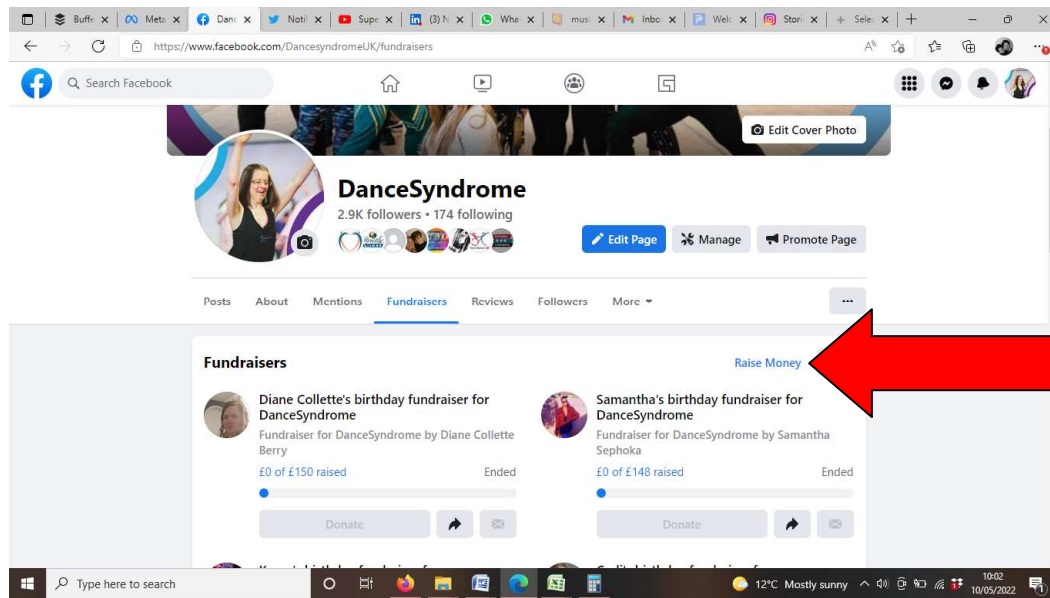


## How to set up a Facebook fundraiser

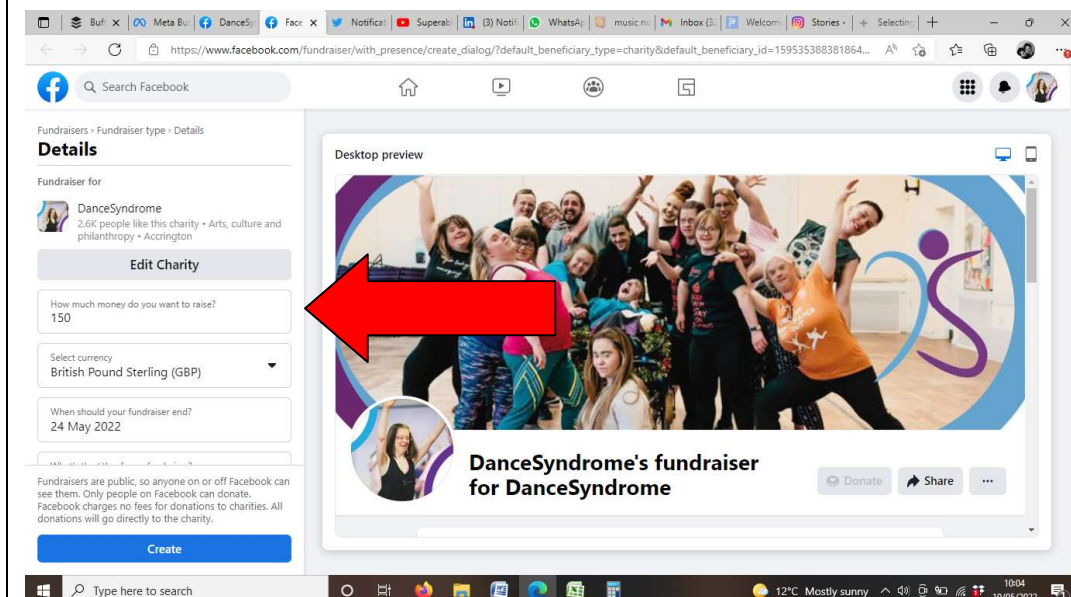
Click on the "Raise Money" link on the right hand side.



Choose how much you want to raise.


It doesn't matter how much you choose.

You can leave this as it is.





You can change this date to one week after your activity to give some time for people to donate later.




