Raise money during an emergency (e.g. Covid-19 outbreak).

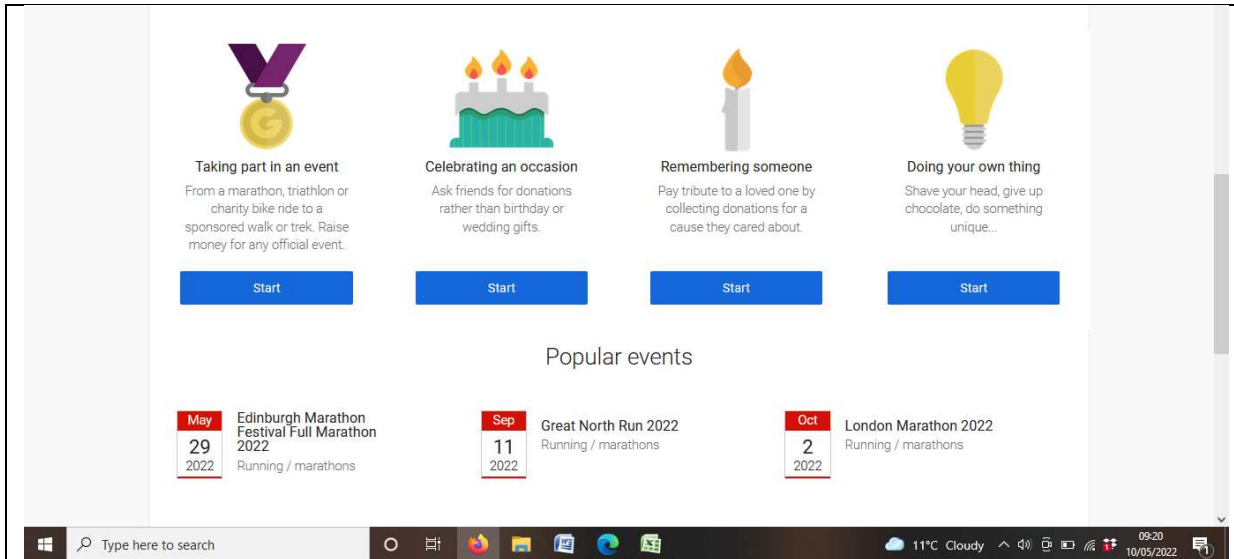
**Fitness at home**

Shave your head, give up chocolate, do something unique...

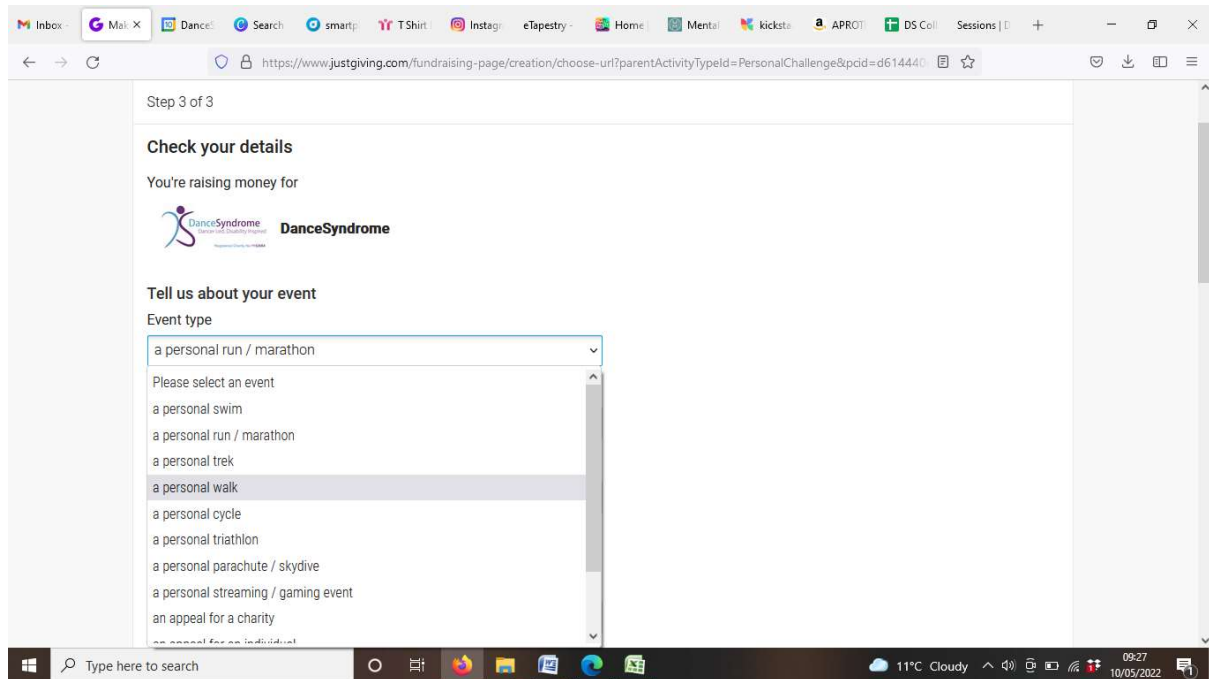

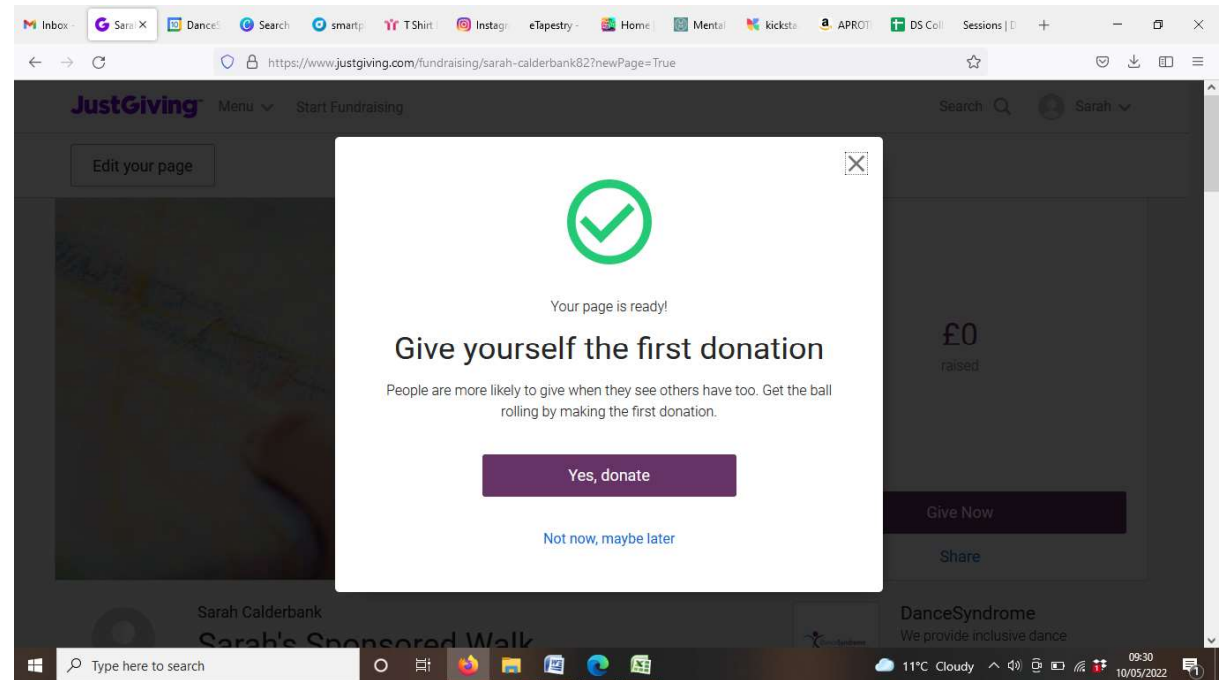

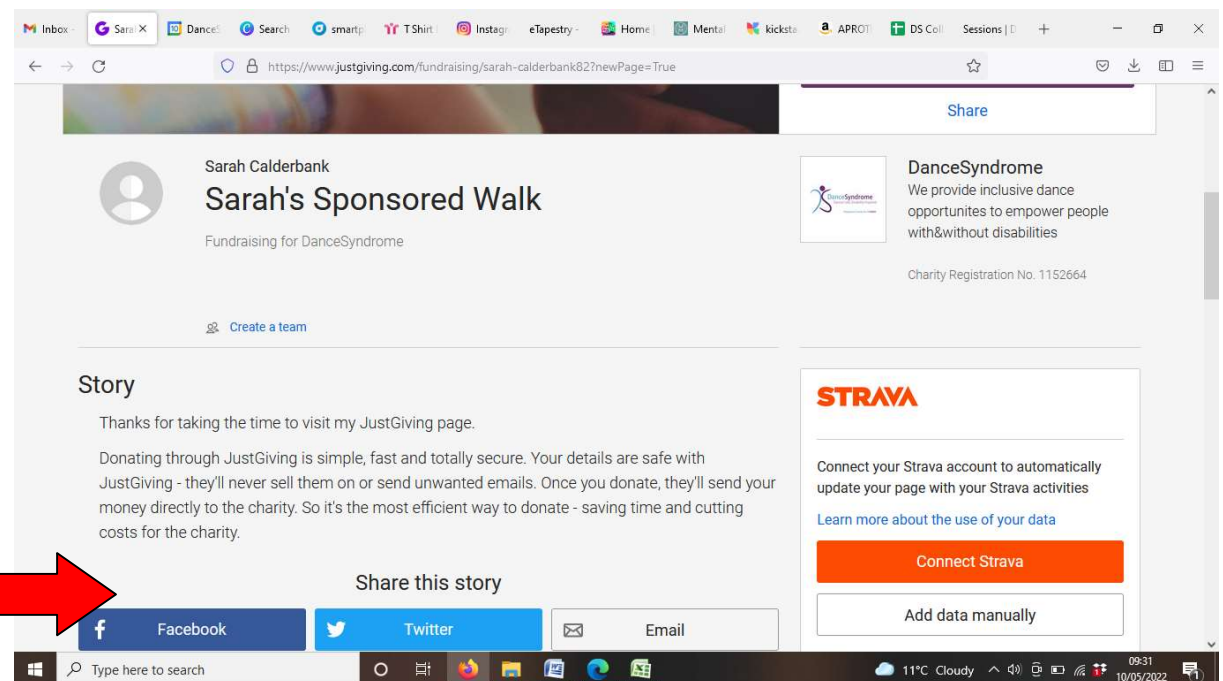
