

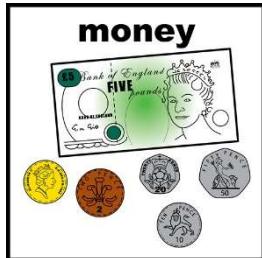
# Lancashire County Council Funding Easy Read Letter

## money

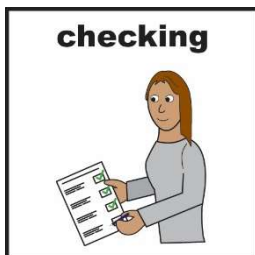


Lancashire County Council have given us some funding for 2 years from April 2023.

The funding is limited so we can only help a limited number of people. Please apply early to avoid disappointment.

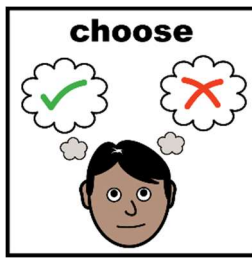
## checking



We will check that:

- you live in Lancashire (not Blackburn or Blackpool)
- you are over 16 years old
- you have a Learning Disability and/or Autism

We cannot use this funding to support people who are already participating with DanceSyndrome.



You can choose to join our Weekly Company Class or one of our Everybody Dance sessions in Accrington, Clitheroe, Chorley, Preston and Blackburn.

We will give you 6 free sessions.

The next 6 sessions will be half price.



You can also choose to do our Dance By Example leadership training at Level 1.

We will support you to use the skills you learn in a dance session.

After the course, we will help you to decide what to do next. That might be more training, a volunteering role or a paid job.
